UNDERTAKING

WHEREAS:

PURSUANT TO SECTION 36(1)(a) OF THE *HEALTH PROFESSIONS ACT* THE INQUIRY COMMITTEE HAS REQUESTED SOHRAB MOHAMMADI TO NOT REPEAT THE CONDUCT THAT WAS THE SUBJECT OF THE COMPLAINT.

SOHRAB MOHAMMADI

Undertakes as follows:

1. He will comply with the *Health Professions Act, Opticians Regulation, College Bylaws, Standards of Practice* and *Code of Ethics*.
2. He undertakes to provide authenticity cards to all patients when available for that brand of lenses.
3. He undertakes to ensure that all patient files contain complete invoicing records (stating the brand of lenses sold) and authenticity cards for lenses sold and that these records be verifiable by a College appointed inspector. He agrees that if any record fails to provide confirmation as to what brand of lenses were dispensed that the College will deem this an incomplete record and, subject to rebuttal by him, an admission that he dispensed the wrong brand of lenses.
4. He undertakes to complete in an in-person education session with the College's Registrar to address the *Standards of Practice* and *Code of Ethics* by June 1, 2015.
