UNDERTAKING AND CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS:

PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 33 AND 36 (1) OF THE *HEALTH PROFESSIONS ACT*, THE INQUIRY COMMITTEE HAS REQUESTED DEVON MARTENS TO UNDERTAKE NOT TO REPEAT THE CONDUCT, WHICH WAS THE SUBJECT MATTER OF THE INVESTIGATION.


Devon Martens

A) undertakes as follows:

1. He will comply with the *Health Professions Act*, *Opticians Regulation*, *College Bylaws* and the *Professional Standards of Practice*;
2. He will immediately cease and desist from conducting auto-refraction on people over the age of 65 without a signed referral from a prescriber;
3. He undertakes not to repeat the conduct which is the subject matter of this complaint of Betty Worley and comply with the *Opticians Regulation* including the *Schedule - Limits and Conditions on the Conduct of Independent Automated Refractions*, specifically section 5 (a) and (c), 6 (c) and comply with the *Professional Standards*, section 8 on *Accepted Practices for the use of Autorefractors/Automated Systems*;
4. He will successfully complete the College of Opticians of British Columbia's Sight Testing Jurisprudence Course within 60 days of this undertaking being signed; and

B) Consents to a reprimand.


