UNDERTAKING AND CONSENT ORDER


WHEREAS:

PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 33 AND 36 (1) OF THE *HEALTH PROFESSIONS ACT*, THE INQUIRY COMMITTEE HAS REQUESTED MAHMOOD SAVJI TO UNDERTAKE NOT TO REPEAT THE CONDUCT, WHICH WAS THE SUBJECT MATTER OF THE INVESTIGATION.

Mahmood Savji undertakes as follows:

1. He will comply with the *Health Professions Act*, *Opticians Regulation*, *College Bylaws* and the *Professional Standards of Practice*;
2. He undertakes not to repeat the conduct which is the subject matter of this complaint of Lise Brine and comply with the *Opticians Regulation* including the *Schedule - Limits and Conditions on the Conduct of Independent Automated Refractions* and the *Professional Standards of Practice*, specifically section 8 (d) and (e) on *Accepted Practices for the use of Autorefractors/Automated Systems*;
3. He will contact Pacific Blue Cross and remove the authorization number (reserve) from Ms. Brine's account within 7 days of this undertaking being signed; and
4. He will successfully complete the College of Opticians of British Columbia's Sight Testing Jurisprudence Course within 60 days of this undertaking being signed.


