In accordance with the *Bylaws* of the College of Opticians of British Columbia (COBC), registrants of COBC are hereby notified of an election of registrants to the COBC Board of Directors. The election period will take place from November 30 to December 31, 2022.

Electoral District 4, Cariboo	3-year term; one registrant to be elected

VOTING:

If there is only one nominee for each of these Electoral Districts, the Registrar will declare the nominees to be elected by acclamation. If there are more than two nominees for either, the Registrar will prepare and deliver an election ballot by November 30, 2022 to all registrants eligible to vote in that Electoral District.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ELECTION

To be eligible, the nominee must:

- be engaged in the practice of opticianry in the electoral district for which they are nominated, or if they are not engaged in practice, must reside in the district for which they are nominated;
- not be in default of payment of any prescribed fees;
- have a certificate of registration that is not subject to a term, condition, or limitation;
- not be a candidate for election in, or already a member of the Board for, another district
